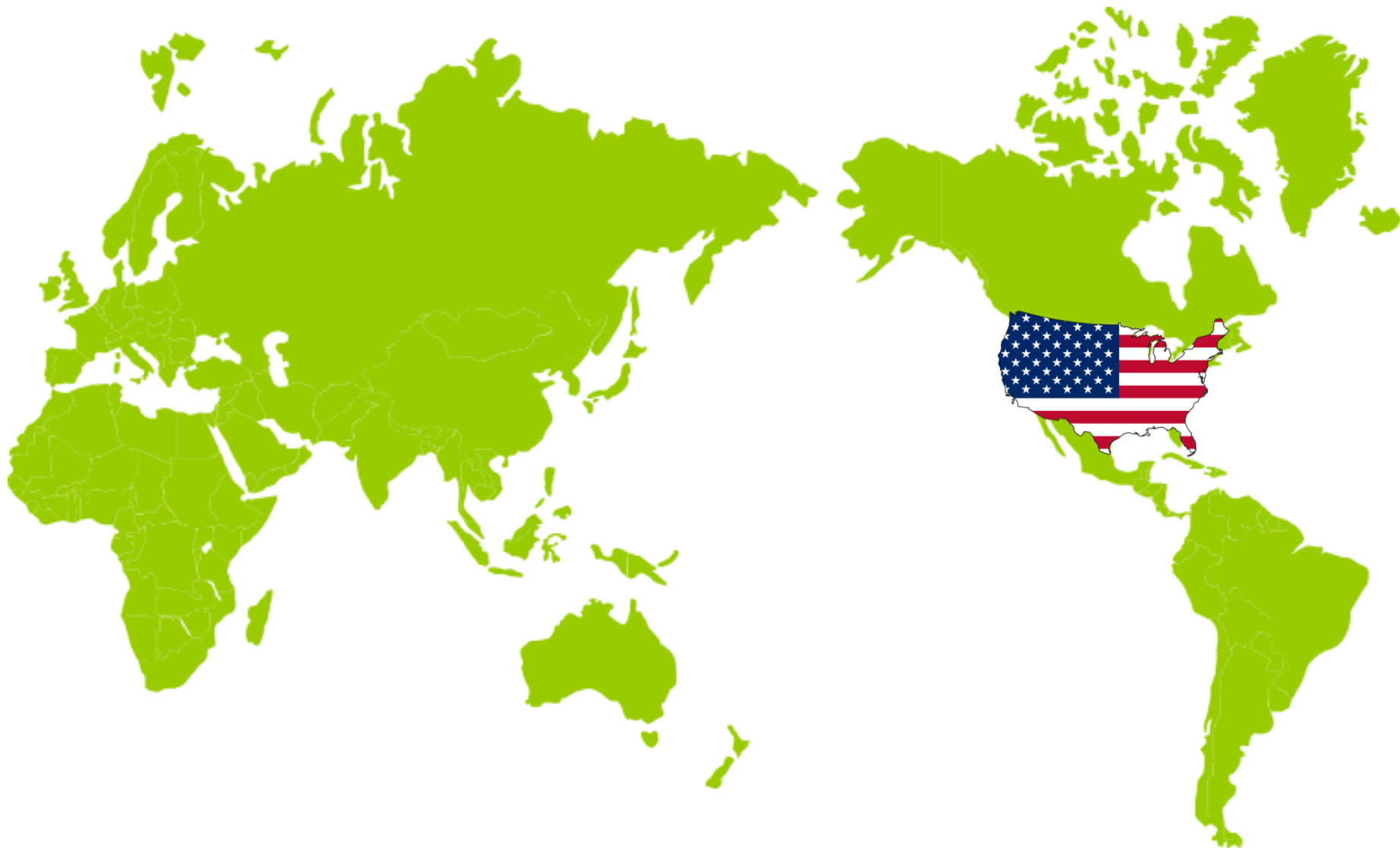

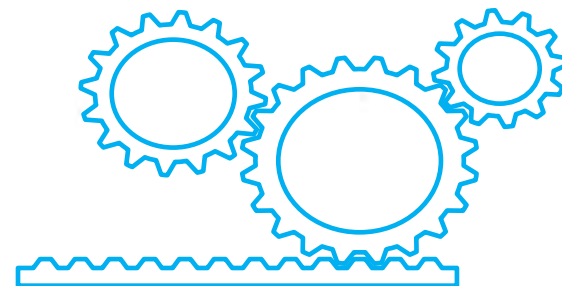

留学[微博]杂志讯 美国东部时间2015年5月26日波士顿，在全球最大的年度教育盛会NAFSA大会上，美国厚仁教育发布了《2015版留美中国学生现状白皮书》(以下简称白皮书)。

作为全球首份重点关注被开除留学生群体的数据报告，白皮书发布后，舆论一篇哗然。

数据显示，被开除的留学群体有以下几方面的共通点：80.55%因学术表现差或学术不诚实而被开除；69.43%来美国不到2年；过半数(51.28%)的学生GPA低于2.0；88.7%的被开除学生为18-25岁；79.04%本科或硕士学位在读。

作为数据发布方的首席发展官，陈航在接受《留学》杂志专访时说，估算被明确开除的中国留美学生，占留学生总数的3%左右，去年被开除的中国学生总数约有8000人。这一数据并不包括无法毕业的中国留学生。

相对于去年27万庞大的赴美留学人数，似乎并不算高。不过，这些数字反映的实际情况，远比人们想象得更严重。

尤其值得注意的是，因为学术不诚实和行为失当造成的开除情况有增加的趋势。被开除

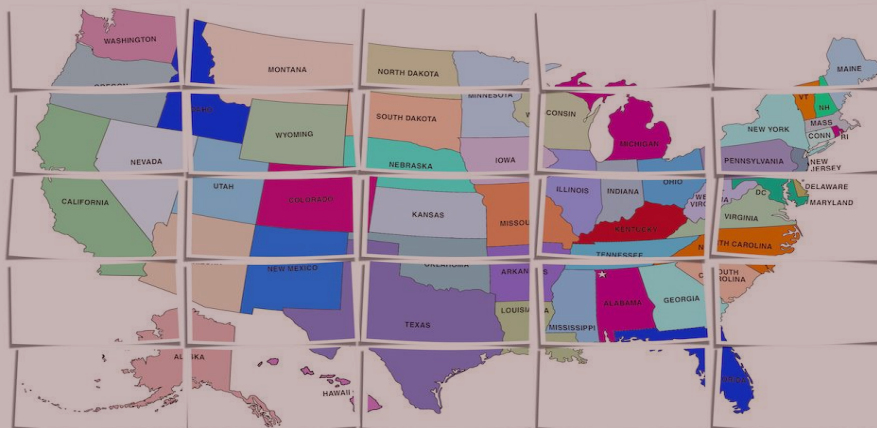

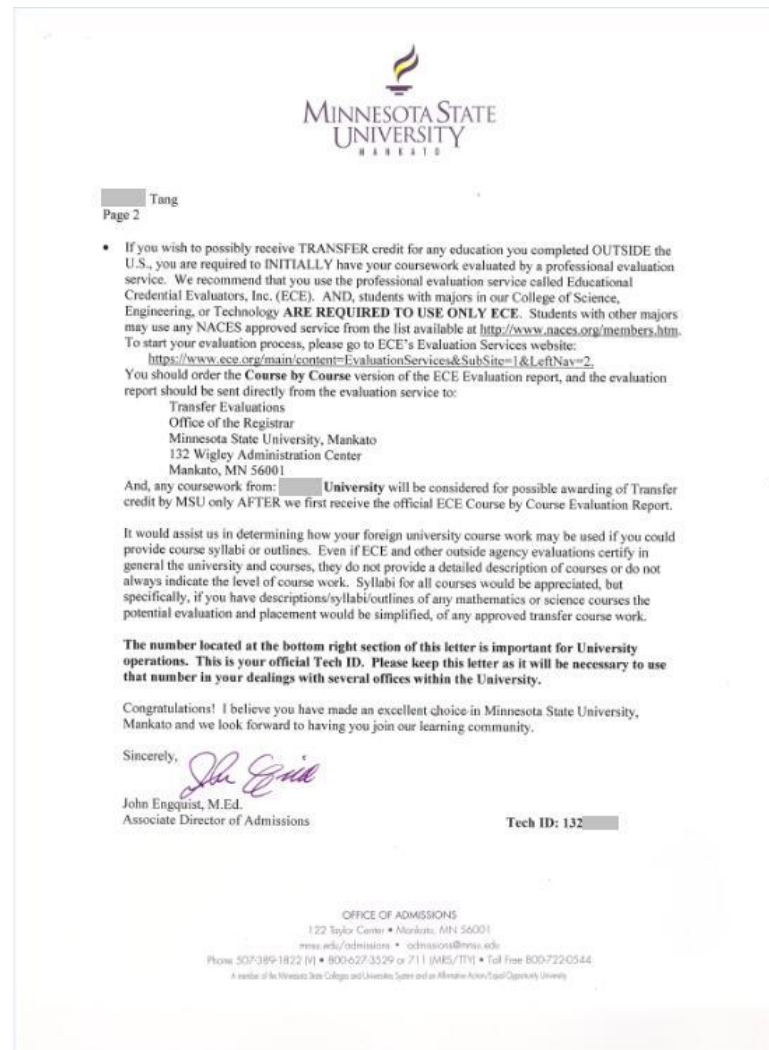
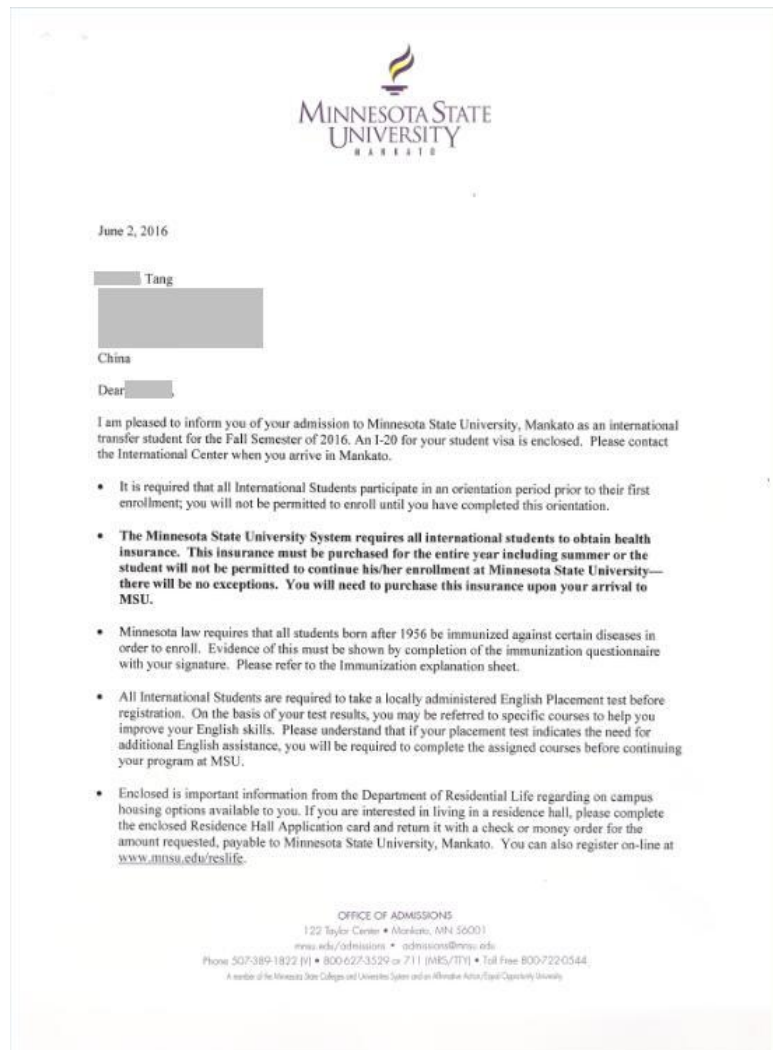
